- We perform extremely well on external turnover and in industrial collaboration!
- ~31% cost on all external turnover. Project overhead+charging own time critical
- We run high-quality educational programs with high employability
- Mid-term changes to budgets
- AAU faces smaller cohorts in North Jutland
- Increased expenses (rent, study admin, cyber security, etc.)
- Long-term plans to reduce housing costs
- We have hired three new Assistant Professors: 1) Peng Mei, 2) Shashi Raj Pandey, 3) Yan Kyaw Tun. Welcome ☺



Growth in Copenhagen

- Long-term plan is to grow to ~400 students by 2030
- Recruitment will focus on Assistant Professor level
- Plans to open one or more new positions in Copenhagen to handle growth+retirments
- New programs proposed:
 - M.Sc. in Computer Engineering
 - B.Eng. In Cyber Security
- Possibility for relocation from Aalborg to Copenhagen



Recruitment Strategy

- Project employees handled by PIs and section heads.
- The Assistant Professor level is critical for our future
- Broad calls for Assistant Professors where the assessment will be based on
 - Excellence
 - Complemetarity
 - Independence
 - Strategic value
 - Teaching value
- Onboarding meeting with HoD
- We expect all our scientific staff to be active in 1) research, 2) teaching,
 3) collaboration, 4) service
